

PROPOSED TOPIC: THE ISLAMIC REVOLUTION OF 1979 AND ITS IMPACT ON US-IRAN RELATIONS

Goal: Explain an event or issue from the news from the issue in historical context

When looking to learn more about a country or a region over a period, look for timelines created by reputable news providers.

To identify a turning point, refer back to general themes: continuity, contingency, change.

Example: This timeline of U.S. - Iran Relations from PBS https://www.pbs.org/newshour/world/a-timeline-of-u-s-iran-relations

This paper will distinguish between two periods:

- I. US-Iran Relations, 1953-1979
- 2. US-Iran Relations, 1979 present day



The scope of a study explains the extent to which the research area will be explored in the work and specifies the variables of interest

We have already established that we want to explore the impact of the Islamic Revolution on US-Iran relations.

Next, we should further narrow the scope of our study by distinguishing a variable of interest –

Possible Variables:

- I. Cultural Relations
- 2. Economic Relations
- 3. Military Relations
